Installation

Environment



1. STATUS LED

In normal operation, the green LED flashes every 0.5 seconds.

2. Contact closure I/O terminal

CONTACT IN: Input for contact closure (Dry contact) CONTACT OUT: Output for contact closure (N.O : Normally Open, Dry contact)



3. Factory reset switch

This switch initializes the device settings.

When pressed for more than 20 seconds, the STATUS LED blinks quickly.

* Do not remove the power until normal operation (blinks 0.5 seconds).

Ethernet port (RJ-45, PoE)

Connect a PoE (Power over Ethernet) switch

- * Default IP address: 192.168.1.99 (Static)
- * The recommended Lan cable is 0.15Ω/m cable within 100m when PoF is used and 0 10/m cable within 100m when PoE+ is used. The total DC resistance of the Lan cable is 150 or less when PoE is used and 100 or less when PoE+ is used

Micro SD card slot

Insert a Micro SD card to this slot

6. Ground terminal

This is the terminal used to ground the equipment.

* It is highly recommended to make the ground connection as short as possible.


7. Line Output terminal (3p Euro Block)

Balanced audio output


SPEAKER (8Ω) terminal


Connect a speaker to this terminal. Refer to the diagram below for the connection
