

Part Names and Function



1. STATUS LED

During normal operation of the equipment, the green LED blinks at 0.5 second intervals

2. ETHERNET CONNECTION TERMINAL (RJ-45, POE)

Connect with network equipment that supports PoE (Power over Ethernet).



3. FACTORY RESET SWITCH


This is the factory reset switch for your equipment. If you hold down the switch for more than 20 seconds, the STATUS LED blinks rapidly and initialization proceeds.

This terminal is used for equipment grounding.


